Side Hinged Steel Garage Doors

The Rowley Range, steel side hinged doors, now benefit from a significantly improved form of construction. This allows BGID to provide these new doors with an inner skin, which substantially improves aesthetic values, adds to panel integrity without weight penalty and without a price disadvantage over our earlier doors.

Inner Door Skin now as Standard

The **Rowley Range**, steel side hinged garage doors, are normally fitted within BGID's own unique cold rolled, rebated section, galvanised steel frame, incorporating as standard, a zinc plated and powder coated finished **full**

height continuous hinge.

Where the doors are to be fitted into a timber frame, BGID supply 3x 100mm (4") galvanized steel butt hinges – these are also powder coat paint finished to match the door panel colour.





Door Openings

The first opening, or access door, is supplied as standard with a Rim Nightlatch and 2 x keys with brass face and convenient matching brass finger pull. The closing edge of this door and the adjacent panel are both provided with cloaking strips for enhanced security.

The slave, or second opening leaf, is offered, as standard, with the option of either Bi-Fold action or Fixed. It is then fitted with the appropriate number of 150mm sprung action, chain operated, top bolts and 150mm foot operated, bottom bolts providing security and convenience.

All sets of **Rowley Range** garage doors are supplied, as standard, with a pair of **overhead door stays** to conveniently and securely hold the doors open at 90°.

Powder Coating

All Rowley Range, steel side hinged garage doors and frames are supplied fully powder coat paint finished. The whole process taking place at BGID's own inhouse continuous process powder coat paint plant.

White is our most popular colour, but BGID offer a further extensive rang of standard colours at no additional cost. Even a white frame with a coloured door is no problem to BGID and again does not incur additional charge.

BGID normally supply the powder coat paint in a textured finish, but matt and semi-gloss are available in most colours, but check before ordering.







Size Range Chart

No standard sizes - all doors are made to measure

Two Thirds & One Third split: Brickwork Opening		
Opening	Min	Max
Width	5' 1 1/4'' (1810)	9′ 8½′′ (2960)
Height	6' 3/4'' (873)	7' 3/8'' (2 70)
Half & Half Split: Brickwork Opening		
Opening	Min	Max
Width	7' 9¾'' (2380)	11'2½'' (3416)
Height	6' 3/4'' (873)	7' 3/8'' (2 70)

The information above is based on using BGID's own steel frame - where a timber frame is used (not by BGID) these dimensions may alter.

Options

- Doors are normally supplied with BGID's own rebated section steel frame, but can be supplied ready to fit within a timber sub-frame (not by BGID)
- Flashing to cover exposed brickwork or unsightly gaps can be supplied manufactured from galvanized steel, and powder coat paint finished to match the frame
- Access doors, whether separate, or part of the garage door, can be right hand or left hand, or in some cases centre opening
- Mortice Locks with lever handles; mortice dead locks, extra security bolts, letter plates, even cat flaps are available
- Choice of leading styles where windows are incorporated
- Choice of powder coat paint finish
- Doors are normally arranged to open out, but opening into the garage is an option
- Door and frame units are normally fitted between brickwork, but can easily be fitted to the outside face to maximise drive through width and height.
